

Prof. Oleg Medvedev graduated from the 1-st Pavlov Medical Institute, Leningrad, in 1970. From 1982-1992 he was the head of the Laboratory of Experimental Pharmacology at the Institute of Experimental Cardiology of National Cardiology Research Centre in Moscow. From 1992 to 2000, he was the founder and the first Dean of the Faculty of Fundamental Medicine at Lomonosov Moscow State University. From 1992 till present – Chair of Department of Pharmacology at the Faculty of Fundamental Medicine.

Oleg Medvedev is an advisor to the Ministry of Public Health on telemedicine, m-health and healthy style of life.
